
















Bottom line

- Materials you physically send must convince the "prospect" to make you worth a special trip.
- Once they arrive, market the complementary activities that will get them to stay longer and come back again.
- Your website: primary lure first, then the "while you're here..." activities.


Your printed materials MUST be good enough to close the sale or to drive customers to your website for additional details.

- Offer to mail it for them.


